Ask the person if s/he, or someone s/he knows, has adopted a pet from the Indiana County Humane Society in the past 40 years. The answer will most likely be "yes."

Thanks to the vision of Lucy Rae Donnelly, 1970s founder, years of committed shelter staff, passionate volunteers and generous residents of Indiana County, the shelter provides a safe haven for stray, abused and unwanted animals.

"We could not be more excited to actually see the new building evolving from the ground up," said Campaign Co-Chair Rosemary Corrigan. "No more blueprints--our dream is becoming a reality."

Young and Associates created the drafting plans, while CNC Construction of Penn Run laid the block on the 9,100 square foot concrete pad and roofed the building this fall.

Although this dream of a new shelter has been top of mind for those closest to ICHS, the

Indiana County community hasn't been privy to most of the behind the scenes work that's involved in raising almost \$2 million.

"By inviting the community to visit the new shelter site, we hope it will inspire those who have not yet supported our fundraising efforts to help us reach our goal," said Rosemary Corrigan, Campaign Co-Chair.

ICHS is in the "tail end" phase of the *Unleash the Possibilities Campaign* with only **\$500,000** left to raise.

This final portion of the campaign will focus on raising funds to provide amenities needed for an innovative shelter such as: basic medical equipment, spacious cat cages, kennels for every sized dog, shelter supplies, office furniture and reception seating, exam tables, etc.

Without these important "finishing touches," our shelter animals will have to wait longer to move in!

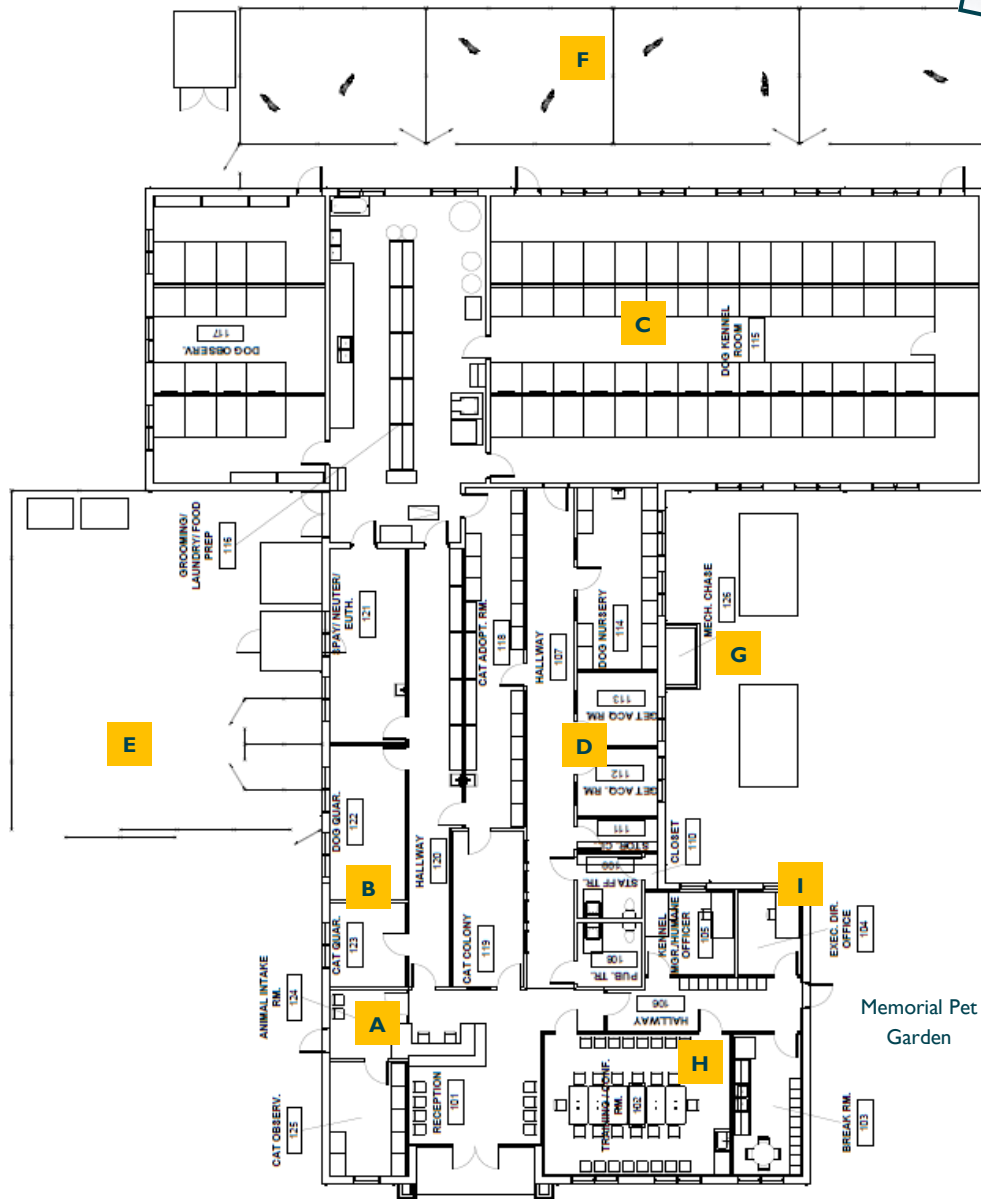
