

LAWNMOWER REVISED JANUARY 15, 2013

1. Long pants, long sleeve shirt, work boots, gloves, eye protection, and Dot helmet MANDATORY.
2. The garden lawnmower must have a factory frame. Homemade frames, adding metal to middle of frame NOT PERMITTED.
3. Must be front engine mower. Rear engine mowers NOT PERMITTED.
4. All mowers must have stock engines.
5. Transaxle must be factory, reinforcing or spider gears are allowed.
6. Reinforcing around the engine is allowed, but can't be to outside of hood.
7. Hoods must remain factory, can be screwed down or welded. If hoods are fiberglass, you can make a hood from steel, but not allowed to be any bigger than original hood.
8. Brakes must work when pulling in for heat race. You must also have forward and reverse.
9. Gas tank must be fastened with cap on. If it comes loose or gas leaks you will be disqualified.
10. Some sort of leg guard is mandatory before entering the arena. It must go from rear fender to front foot rest or frame. It may go to front of hood, it must not touch hood. NO EXCEPTIONS. You must have ankle protection. It is to be maximum 1/8" plate from outside of leg guard to foot rest.
11. A rear bumper any bigger than 3" wide, extend past the inside of tires or extend more than 12" from frame is NOT PERMITTED. If you run a rear bar behind the seat, you cannot tie it in with rear bumper.
12. You may change pulleys to increase speed.
13. You may modify drive train, but it must stay belt driven.
14. You must remove mower decks before entering the pit area. You must remove all plastic items and headlights.
15. The front frame under grille may be strengthened for hitting, but must be smooth finish. Front bumper any bigger than 3" wide, extend past the inside of tires or extend more than 12" from frame is NOT PERMITTED.
16. Straight stack no angle cuts allowed.
17. If driver rolls over or any part of their body touches the track they are disqualified.
18. In the event of a roll over the event will be stopped until officials get the mower back upright.
19. Tire chains are permitted, on rear tires only. Wheel weights permitted. Maximum 50 pounds
